

- 1. Update the basic building blocks of new development

- 5. Develop city-wide land use plan for employment areas
- 6. Establish a Rapid Mass Transit Corridor
- 7. Reinvent the bus transit system based on the RMT Corridor
- 8. New roads and bridges
- 9. Develop and implement funding strategies
