

### **Integrated Growth Strategies**



- 1. Update the basic building blocks of new development
- 2. Establish infill corridors
- 3. Continue to support strategic infill areas
- 4. Amend policies and develop incentives to support neighbourhood infill
- 5. Develop city-wide land use plan for employment areas
- 6. Establish a Rapid Mass Transit Corridor
- 7. Reinvent the bus transit system based on the RMT Corridor
- 8. New roads and bridges
- 9. Develop and implement funding strategies



### **IGP – Integrated Team Approach**

Five Innovation Teams have been formed:

- Nodes & Corridors
- Rapid Mass Transit
- North River Crossing
- Employment Area Plan
- Water, Wastewater, Utilities

Combination of internal and external resources to refine plan.
